Dubai has best buses to woo passengers

Dubai Dubai is using one of the best city public transport buses in the world in a bid to attract more people to use buses instead of private cars, said a senior

"I challenge that we have the best city transport buses in the world and we are determined to further improve our public transport system by completing the ongoing and the new projects," said Eisa Abdul Rahman Al Dossari, Chief Executive Officer of the Public Transport Agency (PTA) at the Dubai Roads and Transport Authority

Al Dossari told Gulf News that the PTA has not abandoned any of its expansion plans to ensure a fully integrated public transport system in the city.

"We have just stretched the implementation period a little bit to suit the changing needs of public transport," he added.

Al Dossari, however, ensured that all plans prepared by the PTA are in place. "We will increase the number of buses from the current 1,575 to 1,900 by the end of this year in addition to the completion of the bus depots.
